Based on your letter dated January 11, 2007, a technical representative of the Department of State (DOS) reviewed your request for a minor modification to the design of RSA's 5-inch footing, shallow mount bollard system which was previously certified on July 27, 2005 under the provisions of SD-STD-02.01, Revision A, *Test Method for Vehicle Crash Testing of Perimeter Barriers and Gates*, dated March 2003.

Upon review of the provided drawings and discussions held with you, the minor modification is hereby granted as outlined in the attached drawings and mentioned in your request; specifically, that a field adjustment be allowed of the tested unit using integral leveling plates and leveling set screws to match adjacent grade and pitch. Based on the previous certification, a review of the submitted drawings and analysis of the existing data, no less than the five bollard system, as previously tested, should be installed with this approved minor modification in order to meet the current certification.
